ACADEMIC SESSION 2026 • 6 SUBJECTS

Pre-primary syllabus for the 2026 session. Learning at this stage is activity based; the textbooks and expectations below guide the year's work.

English (Language Development)

Textbook: 1. *Begin with Alphabet*

COURSE CONTENT

No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Develop listening and speaking skills first.
2	Introduce Alphabets.
3	Introduce objects, colors, animals, family members, etc.
4	Use rhymes, stories, and conversations daily.
5	Show pictures and ask children to identify and name them.
6	Encourage children to repeat words and phrases.
7	Introduce basic letter recognition (A–Z), not forcing writing initially.
8	Children should be able to recognize letters, speak simple words, and understand basic instructions.

Writing Skills (Pre-Writing)

Textbook: 2. *Begin with Capital Writing*; 3. *Begin with Lines & Strokes*

COURSE CONTENT

No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Develop fine motor skills before actual writing.
2	Practice tracing, scribbling, pattern writing (lines, curves).
3	Use sand, air writing, and finger activities.
4	Gradually introduce alphabet and number writing.
5	Children should be able to hold a pencil properly and write basic letters/numbers.

Rhymes & Music

Textbook: 4. *Begin with Rhymes & Stories*

COURSE CONTENT



No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Develop memory, rhythm, and confidence.
2	Teach action songs and rhymes with expressions.
3	Encourage participation, not perfection.
4	Use music for engagement and fun.
5	Children should confidently recite rhymes with actions.

Mathematics

Textbook: (Pre-Number Skills); 5. Begin with Number Book

COURSE CONTENT

No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Build number sense, not memorization.
2	Teach counting through objects, toys, and daily activities.
3	Introduce numbers (1–10 or more depending on level).
4	Teach concepts like big/small, more/less, tall/short, shapes.
5	Use games and hands-on materials.
6	Children should recognize numbers, count objects, and understand basic concepts.

Art & Craft

Textbook: 6. Classic Art Master-A

COURSE CONTENT

No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Encourage creativity and motor skills.
2	Provide activities like coloring, drawing, pasting, tearing, clay modelling.
3	Allow free expression—avoid over-correcting.
4	Appreciate every child's effort.
5	Improved hand coordination and creativity.

General Instructions for Nursery, LKG & UKG Teachers

COURSE CONTENT



No.	Lesson / Topic
1	Be patient, loving, and encouraging at all times.
2	Avoid scolding or comparing children.
3	Focus on learning through play, not pressure.
4	Use visual aids, activity-based teaching, and storytelling.
5	Give equal attention to all children.
6	Maintain cleanliness and discipline in the classroom.
7	Communicate regularly with parents about the child's progress.
8	To Make Children Smarter and Confident
9	Encourage children to ask questions and express themselves.
10	Give them small responsibilities (e.g., arranging books, helping others).
11	Appreciate and reward even small achievements.
12	Promote good habits: greeting, sharing, cleanliness, respect.
